HARTFORD, Connecticut --- Maj. Gen. Thad Martin, Adjutant General and Commander of the Connecticut National Guard, announces that Sean Connolly, Commissioner of the Connecticut Department of Veteran Affairs, will address current and former armed service members at the 67th Annual Armed Forces Day Luncheon at the Aqua Turf Club in Southington, Connecticut, on Friday, May 20, 2016, at noon.

This event is open to the media, beginning at 11:00 a.m.

On August 31, 1949, Secretary of Defense Louis Johnson announced the creation of Armed Forces Day to replace separate Army, Navy, Marine Corps and Air Force Days. The Armed Forces Day Luncheon provides an opportunity to recognize the men and women of Connecticut who serve in the Armed Forces of the United States.

Connolly, a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army Reserve, is an East Hartford native who worked most recently as Pratt & Whitney's Global Ethics and Compliance Officer prior to his confirmation. He is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom, serving as a Prosecutor and Brigade Legal Advisor with the 101st Airborne Division in both Kuwait and Iraq.
