Survivor Outreach Services

Survivor Outreach Services provides casualty continuum of care (long term support) to military families of our fallen, who died serving our country. Whether the death occurred on or off active duty, in combat or not; in an accident; from illness; by suicide, homicide or from natural causes does not matter for services. We can assist spouse, children, parents, step-parents, foster parents, siblings, fiancés, significant others, and even friends of the service member. We can provide direct services as well as information, referrals, recommendations and milestone management of services available. We can connect individuals with peer groups, bereavement and financial counselors, and assist in requesting copies of documents, obtain answers to questions, and direct you to additional Survivor resources. The kinds of benefits and entitlements may vary with the cause of death, military status at time of death and the relationship with the service member, but the eligibility for assistance doesn't change.

Survivor Outreach Services also can assist spouses of military deceased retirees (those drawing a military pension or eligible to draw a military pension at time of death) in submitting for military Survivor Benefits if eligible, and will provide assistance in contacting a representative to assist with Dependency and Indemnity Compensation claims through the VA.

Survivor Outreach Coordinators can:

- * Offer expertise on State & Federal Survivor benefits
- * Arrange for estate and financial advice
- * Arrange for mental health support/counseling
- * Provide assistance in obtaining military reports
- * Provide resource referrals for:
 - Peer Support
 - Bereavement Counseling
 - Emergency Financial Services
 - Military Legal Assistance
 - TRICARE
 - Educational Benefits
 - Benefits Assistance
 - Non-government Organizations that offer benefits to Survivors
