MEMORANDUM FOR US Army Personnel Residing in the United States Army Garrison Rheinland-Pfalz (USAG RP) Community

SUBJECT: USAG RP Command Policy Letter # 14, Uniform Policy in Physical Fitness Centers

1. References:

2. This is a Punitive Policy.

3. Purpose: To establish a single uniform policy for US Army Members using Physical Fitness Centers through the USAG Rheinland-Pfalz Area of Responsibility.

4. Applicability: This policy applies to all US Army Soldiers, Active Duty, Army Reserve and National Guard.

5. General:

a. The Army is a profession and a Soldier's appearance measures part of their professionalism. Proper wear of Army uniforms is a matter of pride for all Soldiers. All Soldiers will maintain a high professional standard when wearing the Army Improved Physical Fitness Uniform (IPFU) in Garrison Physical Fitness Centers.


b. Effective immediately, the following uniform standard is in place:

1. Physical Fitness Uniform (IPFU) or Appropriate Civilian Attire.
2. Army Combat Uniform (ACU) allowed only when conducting Modern Army Combatives or between the hours of 1130-1300.
3. MP3 Players or similar devices are **NOT** authorized for wear in any Military Uniform PFU or ACU.
4. Combat Boots are not authorized on Cardio equipment.

SUBJECT: USAG RP Command Policy Letter # 14, Uniform Standards in Physical Fitness Centers

5. No Muddy or excessively dirty foot gear is permitted inside Fitness Center.
6. Headgear of any type will not be worn in Fitness Centers in any attire.
6. Responsibilities: Soldiers are expected to strictly adhere to this policy. Leaders at all levels will enforce this policy by communicating this through their organizations.
