During peace time, the Indiana Guard is commanded by the governor. In its "state" role, the Indiana National Guard assists the Indiana Department of Homeland Security during emergencies, at the direction of the governor.

Distribution of Soldiers, Airmen, equipment and facilities throughout the state allows the Indiana National Guard to respond quickly and efficiently to emergencies statewide.

FEDERAL MISSION

The Indiana Army and Air National Guard are reserve components of the U.S. Army and U.S. Air Force. During times of national emergency, Indiana National Guard members may be called into active federal service by the President of the United



States.

This dual federal-state mission is unique to the National Guard and sets it apart from any other reserve component.

- 2700+ Soldiers and Airmen deployed to assist clean up and rescue efforts in New Orleans following Hurricane Katrina.
- More than 600 Soldiers and Airmen assisted the Department of Homeland Security in its efforts to secure the border between Mexico and Texas, California, Arizona and New Mexico.
