The NGSG is subject to availability of funds. Grant amounts are based on 30 credit hours of enrollment per academic year, 15 credit hours maximum per semester, UP TO 100% of certain tuition costs and regularly assessed fees. The student must meet the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) standards (minimum GPA & other criteria) as defined by the attended institution. Other eligibility criteria and specific information about the NGSG can be found on the NGSG Information sheet.
