SUBJECT: Summary of the Navy's Management of Operational Test Waivers and Deferrals for Weapon Acquisition Programs (Project No. D2015-D000AE-0157.000)

We plan to begin the subject audit in March 2015. This audit is one in a series starting with Project No. D2014-D000AE-0164.000, "Management of Operational Test Waivers and Deferrals for Department of the Navy Systems," announced June 17, 2014. We also reviewed the management of operational test waivers and deferrals for Naval Sea Systems Command programs. Our objective for this audit is to evaluate the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command process to justify, review, and approve requests for waiver of criteria to certify readiness for operational testing and deferral of operational testing requirements and summarize the results of our evaluation of the Navy's overall management of waivers and deferrals from operational test requirements for Navy systems. We will consider suggestions from management on additional or revised objectives.
