SUBJECT: Off Limits Areas and Establishments

1. **PURPOSE.** To inform all uniformed Armed Services personnel of areas and establishments that are declared Off Limits in Colorado Springs and surrounding areas.
2. **REFERENCE.** AR 190-24, Armed Forces Disciplinary Control Boards and Off-Installations Liaison and Operations, dated 27 July 2006.
3. **APPLICABILITY.** This memorandum applies to all uniformed Armed Forces personnel in the Fort Carson AOR regardless of assignment.
4. This list is current as of 25 January 2016, and supersedes the Off Limits Areas and Establishments memorandum published in December of 2015. Changes from the previous memorandum include the following.
