Lieutenant Colonel Courtney L. Abraham Commander, Army Field Support Battalion - Bragg

LTC Courtney L. Abraham assumed command of the 406th Army Field Support Battalion – Bragg August 2016. He is a native of Shreveport, LA., where he is the youngest of four children.

LTC Abraham enlisted in the Louisiana Army National Guard in 1995 as a Petroleum Supply Specialist. His initial assignment was with the 256th Infantry Brigade (1995-1998). LTC Abraham graduated from the University of Louisiana-Monroe and was commissioned a Quartermaster Officer in 1998. His first duty assignment was with the 142d CSB, JRTC & Fort Polk, where he served as a Platoon Leader, Executive Officer and Battalion S1/Adjutant. Following his promotion to Captain, he was assigned to the 7th Corps Support Group, Bamberg, Germany (Warner Barracks) where he served as the Supply & Services Officer, then assumed command of the 240th Quartermaster Supply Company where he deployed his unit twice in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom. Following company command, LTC Abraham served as the Deputy Group S3 until being reassigned to the US Army Human Resources Command (HRC) in Alexandria, VA as the Quartermaster LT/CPT Assignment's Officer from 2006-2008. After completing this tour, LTC Abraham was assigned to the 4th Brigade Combat Team, 1st Armored Division as the 121st Brigade Support Battalion Executive Officer. He held this position for two years and following a deployment with the BCT to Iraq, he was selected for the Marine Corps Command and Staff Course at Quantico, Marine Base. His next assignment was with HQ, Defense Logistics Agency at Ft. Belvoir, VA where he served as a Joint Plans and Operations Officer. Subsequently, LTC Abraham was reassigned to the HQ, Army Materiel Command in Redstone, AL and selected to serve as the Assistant Executive Officer & Aide-de-Camp to the Commanding General.



LTC Abraham's military education includes: Quartermaster Officer Basic Course, Petroleum Officer Course, Military Personnel Officer's Course, Combined Logistics Captains Career Course, Combined Arms & Services Staff School, Support Operations Course, Marine Corps Command and Staff Course, and the Joint & Combined Warfighting School. His civilian education includes a Master of Science Degree from the Marine Corps Command & Staff College.
