Contractor Serious Mishap Burns from Ignited Floor Mastic





- •Injury: Severe burns to two contractor employees and minor burns to one contractor employee
- Damage: Approximately \$500,000
- •Activity: Workers were removing asbestos floor tile mastic, using paint thinner instead of a pre-approved mastic remover, when a temporary light in the containment area fell causing a spark and igniting the thinner

Direct Cause:

> Failure to implement & comply with contract safety specifications

•Root Cause:

>Insufficient controls in Design Build contracts to ensure the necessary contract requirements, drawings, safety plans, and personnel are provided

Lessons Learned:

- >Entire execution team contractor and government personnel – must read and fully understand all contract requirements
- >Prime Contractor and sub-contractors must be held accountable and responsible for initiating and maintaining a proactive safety program
