



# Move In Housing Allowance

- Allowance to defray the move-in costs associated with occupying privately leased quarters covered under the OHA program
- Does not cover move-out costs
- To be eligible for MIHA, must be eligible for OHA
- For expenses which are not covered or reimbursed, try to get the landlord to roll it into the rent



#### Move-In Housing Allowance (MIHA) -- Three Components

- Miscellaneous Upfront, Lump Sum
  - Average Move-In Costs
  - Everyone Receiving OHA Collects
- Rent (DD 2556)
  - Rental Agent Fee
  - \$ for \$ Reimbursement
- Security Crime/Terrorist Threats (DD 2556)
  - Physical Dwelling Modifications
  - \$ for \$ Reimbursement
  - Designated by State Dept; Listed in App N





# MIHA Eligibility

- To be eligible for MIHA, Service members must be receiving OHA.
- Eligible service members may receive MIHA for one dwelling per tour at a PDS unless a government funded local move occurs and the new dwelling is covered under MIHA.



#### **MIHA Miscellaneous**

- Average Move-In Costs
  - Example: Transformers, Heaters, Appliances, Non-Refundable Deposits
  - How Determined: Tri-Annual Survey
  - Up Front -- Move Out Costs Not Covered
  - Payment: When First Entitled to OHA



# MIHA Miscellaneous-Expenses covered

- Major appliances Refrigerator, stove, washer, air conditioner, etc
- Hookup charges Electric, plumbing, phone and heat
- Security and safety items Smoke detector, fire extinguisher (also window bars, locks, alarms when not reimbursed for MIHA Security)
- Other Curtain rods, cabinets, trash barrels (where required), screens, transformers, etc
- Covered expenses can be found in Appendix K Part III, Table I



# MIHA Miscellaneous-Expenses not covered

- Rental agent fees (in some cases covered by MIHA Rent)
- Cleaning/repair costs (covered by dislocation allowance)
- Small or personal appliances (covered by COLA)
- Refundable deposits
- Move-out costs
- Lawn care items
- Expenses not covered can be found in Appendix K Part III, Table II



#### **MIHA Miscellaneous**

#### No MIHA Entitlement When

- Local Move, Unless Gov't Funded
- Member Executes PCS But Remains In Same Dwelling
- Separation or Retirement



#### **MIHA Rental Component**

- Example: Rental Agent Fee (No Housing Office Available)
- How Determined: Receipts
  - Requirements: Local Custom or Law
    >Commander's Approval, DD2556 (Part B)
    -- When In Doubt Senior <u>Service</u>
    Officer In Country Decides
- Payment: \$ for \$ Reimbursement
- Homeowners Ineligible



### MIHA Rent Example

- Landlord charged member 2 month up-front rental fee
- 1 month rental fee customary
- The authorizing/approving official should authorize reimbursement for only 1 month's rental fee



### **MIHA Security Component**

- Security: <u>Physical Dwelling Modification</u>
  - Examples: Security Bars, Alarm System
  - How Determined: Receipts
  - Requirements: Crime/Terrorist Threats
    - Determined by State Dept <u>Appendix N</u>
    - Commander's Approval, DD2556 (Part C)
  - Payment: \$ for \$ Reimbursement
  - Designated MIHA Security Location App N Part II, Table I



# MIHA Security Eligibility -1

- Service members receiving OHA in locations identified in Appendix N Part II of the JFTR as MIHA Security Locations are eligible for MIHA/Security
- Service members reimbursed for personally incurred expenses- only one sharer can be reimbursed for a housing security expense



### MIHA Security Locations

- MIHA Security for a location established or removed annually based on State Department messages
- The list of MIHA Security locations found in the JFTR, Appendix N Part II
- Country POC notified when the country is removed from the MIHA Security list Country POC should notify the locality POCs
- Security upgrades borne by the landlord whenever possible



# **Summary**

- Three types of MIHA
  - MIHA Miscellaneous
  - MIHA Rent
- MIHA Security
- To be eligible for MIHA, must be eligible for OHA
- Does not cover move out costs
- Service members should check with landlord about rolling expenses into the rent
