PMV-2 MISHAPS CLAIM SOLDIERS' LIVES:

Soldier on transitional leave died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 7 November 2014, at approximately 1800 local, in Waynesville, MO. The 47-year-old SFC was operating his motorcycle when he was struck by a four-wheeled vehicle. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and was pronounced dead at the scene.

A Missouri Army National Guard Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 28 September 2014, at approximately 0530 local, in Aurora, MO. The 59-year-old SGT was operating a 1992 Honda motorcycle en route to his drill location when he lost control on a curve and struck a tree. The Soldier was wearing a helmet and was pronounced dead at the scene. The Soldier was reportedly not licensed for motorcycles and had not taken the MSF Course.

Soldier died from injuries sustained in a private motor vehicle (PMV-2) crash that occurred on 6 September 2014, at approximately 0245 local, in Vicenza. The 26-year-old SPC was operating 2005 Honda CBR 600RR when he struck the rear end of a commercial truck. He was ejected from the motorcycle and was struck by a second vehicle while he was on the roadway. Soldier was pronounced dead at the scene. He was trained and wearing full PPE.
