Individual Transition Plan Checklist - Capstone Verification Every Tuesday | 1-2:30 p.m. Please call the A&FRC at (781) 225-2765 to schedule an appointment with a consultant. All AF service members who completed Pre-separation Counseling and TAP/GPS are required to complete

DD Form 2958, Service Member's Individual Transition Plan Checklist (referred to as "Capstone"), prior to separation/retirement. This is a mandatory requirement for out-processing.

Pre-separation Counseling Every Wednesday | 9-11 a.m. Weekly sessions for separating and retiring service members to complete the mandatory DD Form 2648, Pre-separation Counseling. This counseling MUST be provided at least 90 days prior to date of separation or retirement and is a prerequisite for attending the Transition-GPS Workshop.

Pre-deployment Briefing Every Friday | 2-3 p.m. Mandatory for personnel tasked with a TDY/Deployment of 30 days or longer. Spouses are highly encouraged to attend. Briefings are held every Friday at the A&FRC. Please call the A&FRC to sign up.

Family Welcome - Anytime! Stop in after you arrive at Hanscom for a personal welcome to the community and a tour of the A&FRC!
