

Atterbury welcomes Cyber Exercise

EDINBURGH, Ind. – The Army National Guard’s annual response exercise, Cyber Shield is being conducted at Camp Atterbury-Muscatatuck March 9-20, with a focus on developing Industrial Control Systems/Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition defense scenarios.

More than 42 states and territories to include Army National Guard, Air National Guard and Reserve Component service members will participate in the cyber exercise that is designed to develop, train and exercise National Guard cyber-capable forces.

At the beginning of the month the Army National Guard announced the plan to stand up 10 cyber protection teams over the next three fiscal years with Indiana, Michigan and Ohio being the first to be stood up. Cyber Shield prepares the citizen-soldier to defend the network and help boost state and federal cyber defense capabilities.
