Veteran's Memorial Commemoration and Community Day

EDINBURGH, Ind. – The annual Veteran's Memorial Commemoration is scheduled for Saturday, August 15, 2015, at 10 a.m. at Camp Atterbury. The ceremony, which honors all of those who have served at Camp Atterbury, will take place at the Veteran's Memorial Wall.

The ceremony will consist of a prelude by the Southern Indiana Bag Pipes and Drums, keynote speaker and a wreath ceremony to honor units and veterans that have deployed through Camp Atterbury since World War II.

The program is open to the public and promotes goodwill among veterans, military retirees, our community and those currently serving in support of Camp Atterbury.

New this year, directly following the program a Community Day event will be taking place at the Welcome Center and Museum at 11 a.m. to 3p.m. directly across the street from the main gate of Camp Atterbury. The event includes WWII reenactors and displays, current military displays, tours, speakers and more.

Parking is located next to the museum and Veterans Memorial.
