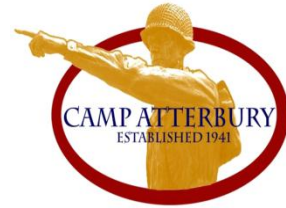

Maj. Gen. Umbarger to dedicate Camp Atterbury North Barracks Complex to Mitch Daniels

EDINBURGH, Ind. – On behalf of more than 15,000 Soldiers, Airmen and state employees of the Indiana National Guard, Maj. Gen. R. Martin Umbarger cordially invites you to attend the Rededication of the Camp Atterbury North Barracks Complex Thursday in Edinburgh, Ind.

In October 2010, Former Indiana Governor Mitch Daniels, along with the Indiana National Guard, the Indiana Department of Natural Resource and the Indiana Department of Corrections, signed an agreement to release nearly 1,200 acres of land in Johnson County. This action made way for revitalizing portions of the original cantonment area of Camp Atterbury dating back to the 1940s.

After nearly three years of construction, the new barracks complex was completed in August 2014, adding an additional 1,200 beds and a dining facility to the north side of post. Since opening the complex has housed military personnel participating in the recent Warfighter exercise.
