Indiana National Guard to take part in search and rescue training

INDIANAPOLIS – Airmen and soldiers with the Indiana National Guard’s premier disaster response team will conduct search and extraction training at Muscatatuck Urban Training Center near Butlerville, Ind., on Wednesday.

The National Guard members, along with local, state, and national emergency response teams, will participate in United Front 2015, a search and rescue operation exercise that will simulate earthquake damage.
