Patient Services Center

The center is located inside the west entrance of the hospital and houses the Patient Advocate Office, Patient- and Family-Centered Care Resource Center, Ombudsman, and American Red Cross. The PAC is open Monday-Friday from 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m. They help patients who have questions, problems or concerns about medical care and/or medical staff. Services provided at no cost include the use of a courtesy phone, computers, and television. They also make copies, send fax, provide community resources, and health information. Translator Service


Interpretive services for sign language and language translation are available at no cost and can be arranged through your healthcare team. Please ask at any clinic's front desk for this assistance if necessary.
