

Inventory Management - Receive Section



101 – A Goods Receipt that references a Purchase Order (PO), Stock Transport Order (STO) or Inbound Delivery 501 – A Goods Receipt without a PO - Found on Installation (FOI) for FOI, use 243 - Reason for Movement

For Turn-Ins

901 – A customer turn-in for a recoverable/reparable item 903 – A customer turn-in for a non-recoverable/reparable item



- 1. Confirm your Transfer Orders (TO)
- 2. Review Transfer Order Reports for unconfirmed TOs (LT22, LT23, LT24)
- 3. Interim Storage Types (IST) 902 to 916 designate a customer issue
- 4. Interim Storage Type (IST) 902-NTF is a holding spot for unserviceable items (Retrograde)
- **5.** NTF-916 is the outbound movement for turn-in from the SSA
- 6. Review the Inbound Delivery Monitor (VLØ6i) for inbound shipments
