



## Movement Types

**101** – A Goods Receipt that references a Purchase Order (PO), Stock Transport Order (STO) or Inbound Delivery

**501** – A Goods Receipt without a PO - Found on Installation (FOI) for FOI, use 243 - Reason for Movement

### For Turn-Ins

**901** – A customer turn-in for a recoverable/reparable item

**903** – A customer turn-in for a non-recoverable/reparable item



## Reminders

1. Confirm your Transfer Orders (TO)
2. Review Transfer Order Reports for unconfirmed TOs (LT22, LT23, LT24)
3. Interim Storage Types (IST) 902 to 916 designate a customer issue
4. Interim Storage Type (IST) 902-NTF is a holding spot for unserviceable items (Retrograde)
5. NTF-916 is the outbound movement for turn-in from the SSA
6. Review the Inbound Delivery Monitor (VL06i) for inbound shipments
