#### **Books**

#### Start your research at the Virtual Branch,

http://www.benning.army.mil/library

Open the Online Catalog from the Virtual Branch front page and search by country name and a stability or instability factor such as education, economy, military, natural resources, etc. for a list of information in the collections.

Your list will include physical information such as books and e-information such as e-books. The list will include information of a historical nature. Be sure to check the publication date of any information you use. This paper requires current information.

You will find special publications at the circulation desk of the library such as:

**The Europa World Yearbook**. This publication is an authoritative reference work providing current detailed information on the political, economic and commercial institutions of counties around the world.

**The Military Balance**. This publication provides an annual assessment of Global Military capabilities and defense economics.

**The World Today Series**. This publication is arranged by region then by country. The history, government, culture and economic situation for each country listed is covered in detail.

**Nations of the World.** This publication is a political, economic and business handbook providing 229 country profiles. The profiles include economic indicators, risk assessments, country and regional maps.

From the front page click the **JANE'S** icon. **JANE'S** provides access to full-text reports and analysis on world conflicts, armies, weapons, defense capabilities, insurgency, terrorism, and more. Check the handout for the login and password.

From the front page click the Online Catalog icon, select the eResources/Research tab. Here you will find several databases that will help you with your research.

## For example:

**Academic Search Elite.** Provides subject access to recently published full text, scholarly, peer-reviewed journal articles.

**MasterFILE Premier.** Contains full text information for nearly 1,700 magazines, journals and newspapers.

**ProQuest Newspapers.** Provides subject access to over 350 newspapers, blogs and wire feeds from around the world.

**CultureGrams.** Provides reports and data on over 200 countries, all 50 United States, and the Canadian Provinces. Information includes daily life, customs, and lifestyles of the world's people. Up-to-date facts and figures are also provided.
