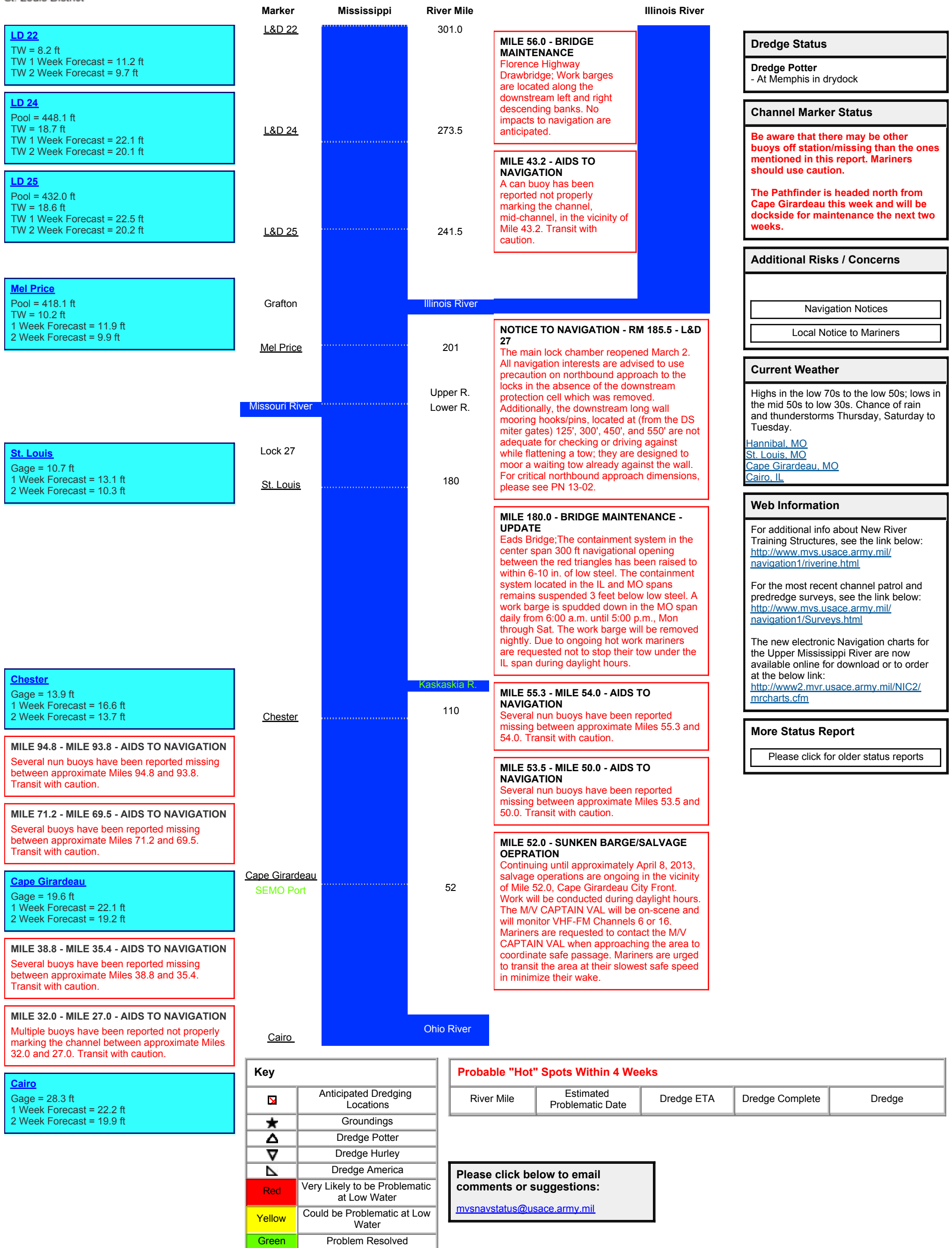




Navigation Channel Condition Status Report - 4 April 2013
