

MILE 22.0 - MILE 35.0 - CHANNEL CONDITION

The river is now open to all river traffic from between Mile 22.0 and 3.5, Upper Mississippi River. It is recommended that upbound traffic contact the M/V CRIMSON GLORY on VHF-FM Channel 13 or by phone at (314) 803-4822, and downbound traffic contact the M/V COOPERATIVE ENTERPRISE on VHF-FM Channel 13 or by phone at (314) 803-4814. Mariners are urged to transit the area with caution due to salvage operations.
