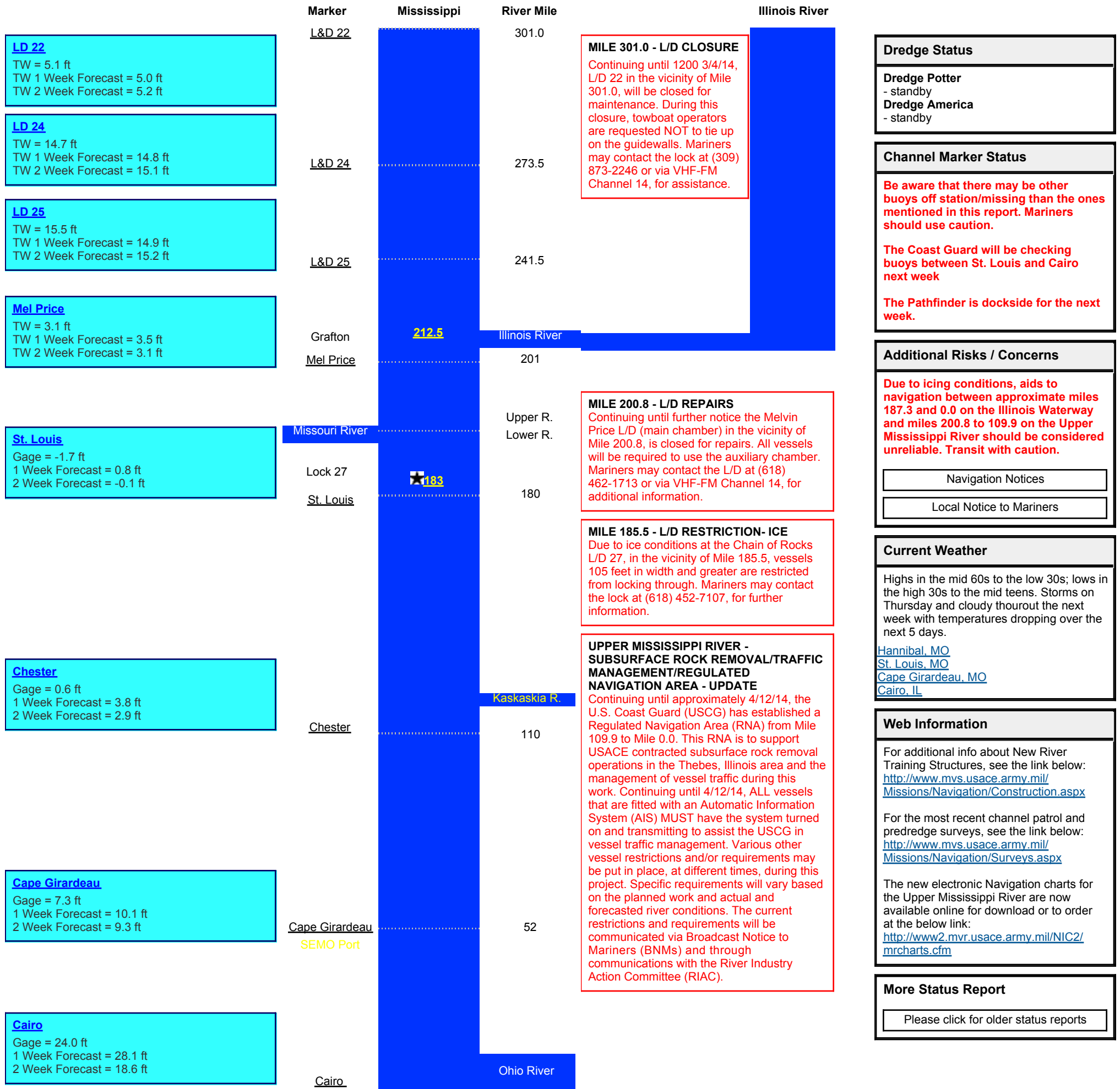




Navigation Channel Condition Status Report - 20 February 2014
