

Motorcycle Safety Courses Offered

WASHINGTON (NNS) -- Navy motorcycle safety training courses will be offered to Sailors during October on a limited, first-come-first-served basis while new instructor schedules are secured for the new fiscal year.

Sailors interested in taking a class may sign up by visiting the Navy's Enterprise Safety Application Management System (ESAMS) website or by checking with their local installation safety office.



Sailors who are qualified motorcycle safety instructors and are interested in volunteering to teach, should contact their local installation safety office. Volunteer instructor courses will be posted on the ESAMS website.

Courses will include: Basic Rider Courses 1 and 2, the Advanced Rider Course, and Motorcycle Sportbike Rider Course.

"Each command has the option to request surge training for a specific number of students, at a specific location, for a specific type of class," said CNIC's Safety Director, Rick Maiello.
