Regional Sediment Budget for the Illinois North Shore

Description

The Illinois North Shore is a highly dynamic and diverse coastline with complex littoral processes complicated by significant coastal infrastructure and active shoreline management. Historically, coastal management has not always been conducted using a coordinated regional approach, which has hindered the efficiency and effectiveness of management activities. The newly established Illinois Coastal Zone Management (CZM) program is developing a comprehensive plan for shoreline management. The development of a regional sediment budget would support the CZM program and provide a valuable tool for Federal, state, and local decision makers.



Issue/Challenge To Address

Existing regional sediment data is currently collected and housed by multiple agencies and stakeholders along the study reach. The challenge of this effort will be to coordinate with the pertinent stakeholders to collect and share the relevant data necessary for constructing the sediment budget.

Successes Lessons Learned

This is a continuation of FY14 study; lessons learned will be included in future fact sheets and final documentation.
