Railroad Safety Advisory Committee Task Statement: Track Safety Standards

Task No.: 07-01

Date initially presented to the RSAC: February 22, 2007

Purpose:

To consider specific improvements to the Track Safety Standards or other responsive actions, supplementing work already underway on continuous welded rail (CWR).

Description:

- Review controls applied to reuse of rail in CWR ("plug rail").
- Review the issue of cracks emanating from bond wire attachments.
- Consider improvements in the Track Safety Standards related to fastening of rail to concrete ties.
- Ensure a common understanding within the regulated community concerning requirements for internal rail flaw inspections.

Issues requiring specific report:

The committee should consider, and specifically report on, issues presented in the description above.
