

Railroad Safety Advisory Committee Task Statement: Revision of the Qualification and Certification of Locomotive Engineers Regulations

Task No.: 96-6

Date presented to the RSAC: October 31- November 1, 1996

Purpose:

To promote the railroad safety by improving the regulations based on additional knowledge and experience gained since the original effective date.

Description:

Recommend revisions to the regulations governing the Qualification and Certification of Locomotive Engineers (49 CFR Part 240), including such additions and deletions as may be required by law or as may be warranted by appropriate data and analysis.

Issues requiring specific report:

All matters related to the revision of the regulations, including data required for regulatory analysis, with the exception of Control of Alcohol and Drug Use issues (*See* issues paper for October 31-November 1, 1996 meeting).
