• What changes are we trying to promote through the development and issuance of B31Q?

 Assure individuals working on tasks affecting pipeline safety or integrity (including construction-related tasks) are qualified.

→ Reduce the number of incidents and accidents for which personnel error is a contributing factor.

→ Reduce the administrative burden on operators to assure contractor personnel are qualified to perform covered tasks.

* Reduce the administrative burden on contractors of qualifying their personnel to perform like tasks for multiple operators.

Increase the assurance that very small operators (e.g., master meters, propane operators) comprehend and comply with personnel qualification requirements.

Assure that training is adequate to support continuing assurance that personnel have requisite skills and abilities to perform covered tasks.

 Assure that reevaluation methods and intervals are adequate to support continuing assurance that personnel have requisite skills and abilities to perform covered tasks.

• How will we be able to recognize if these changes have occurred?
