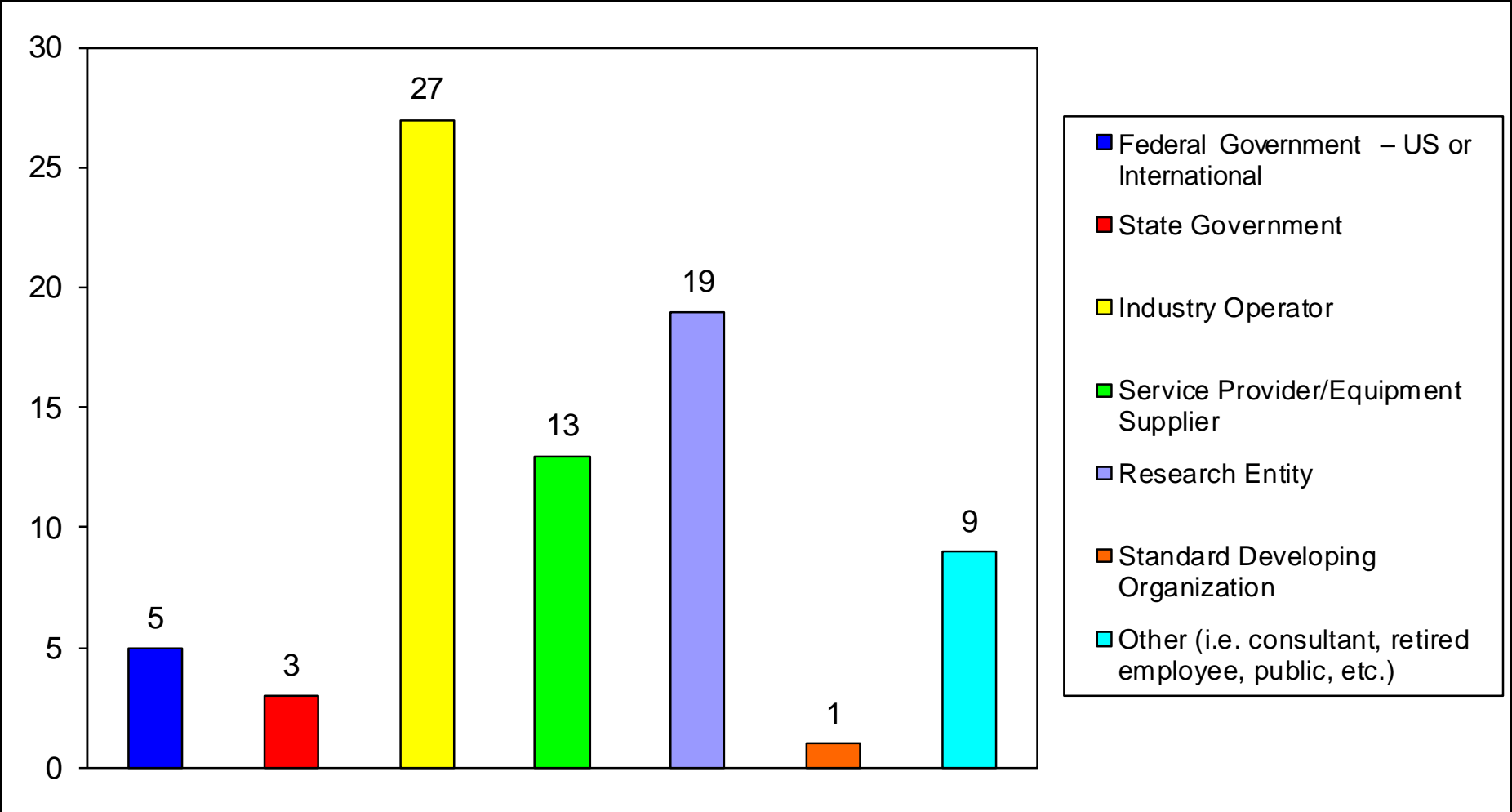

Attendee Survey Result Notes

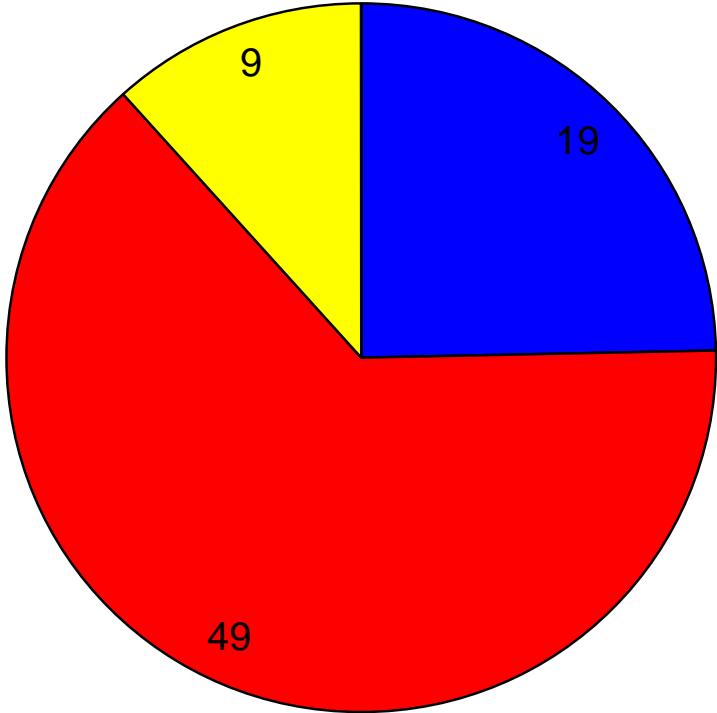
- **77 Survey responses received**

1. What stakeholder group do you represent?

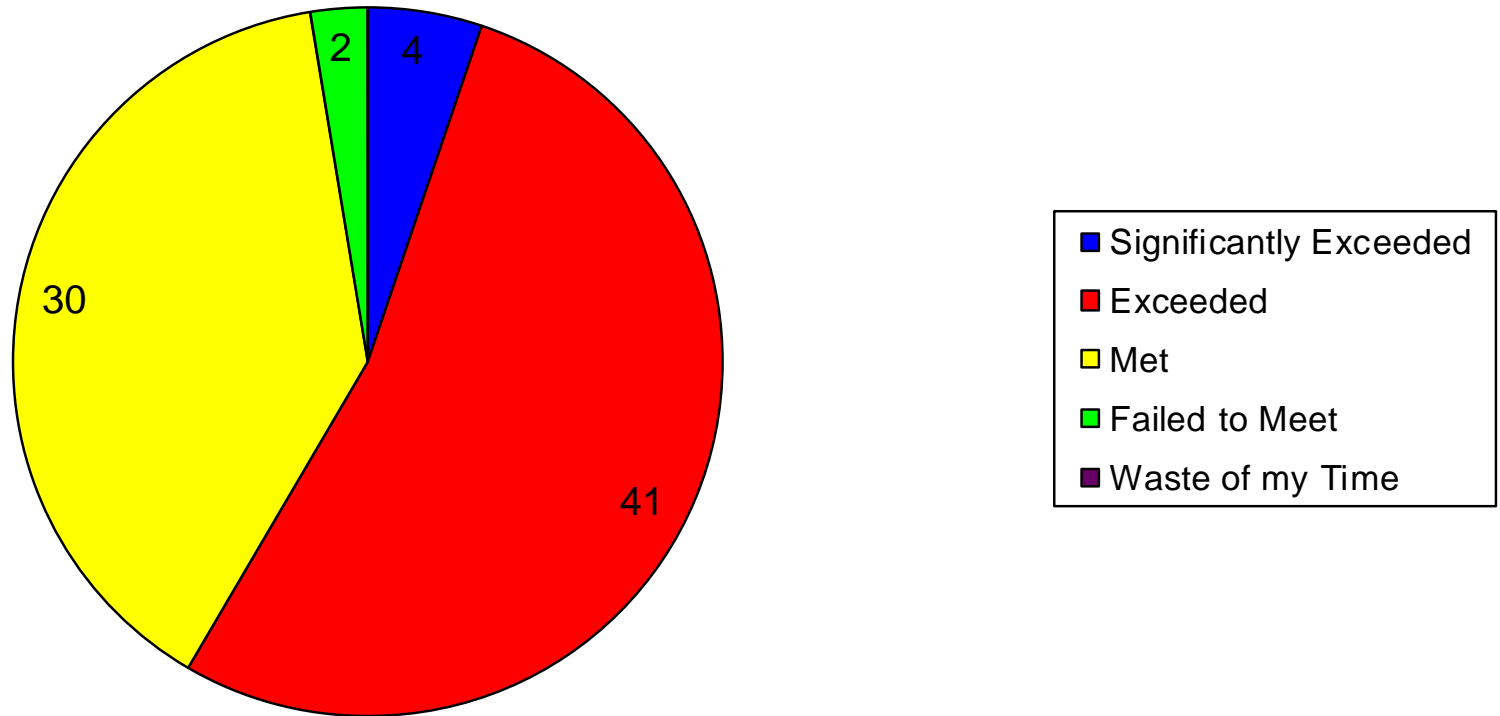

3. Did the Forum meet your expectations?

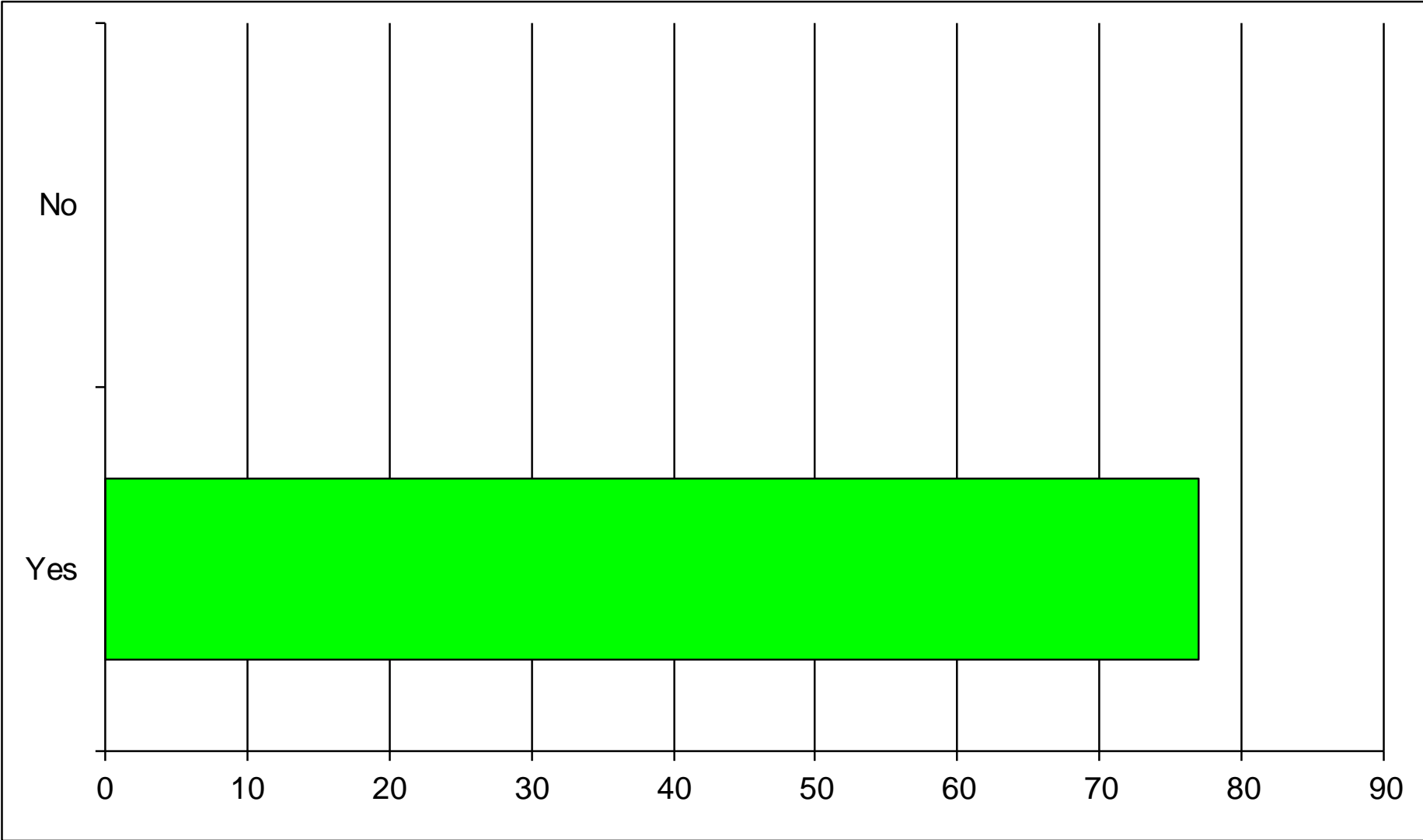


NOTE: Failed to meet comments driven by less open subject design of working groups.

- Learning about and interacting with the CAAP Students.

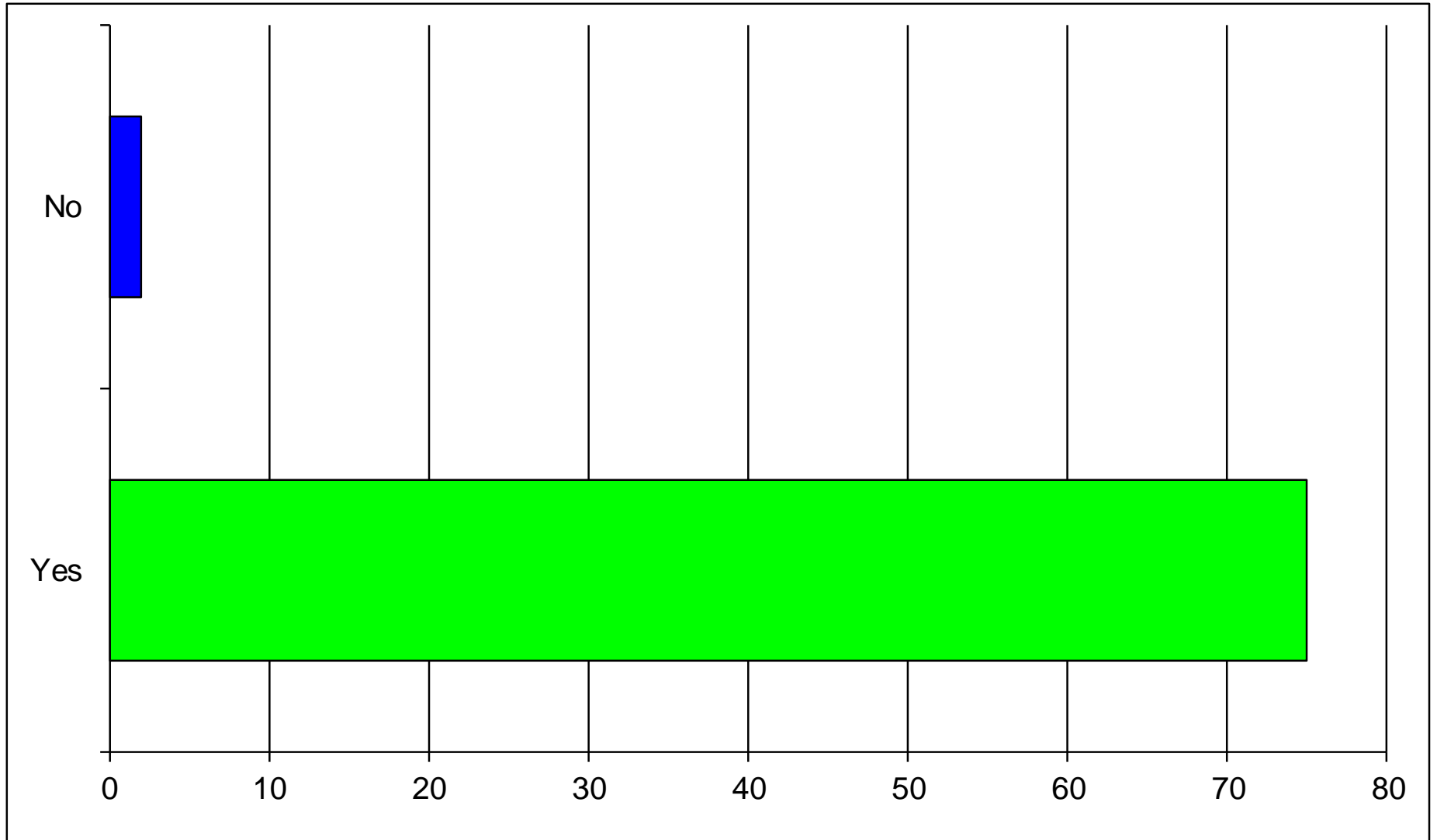
5. Do you expect to use the Forum results?



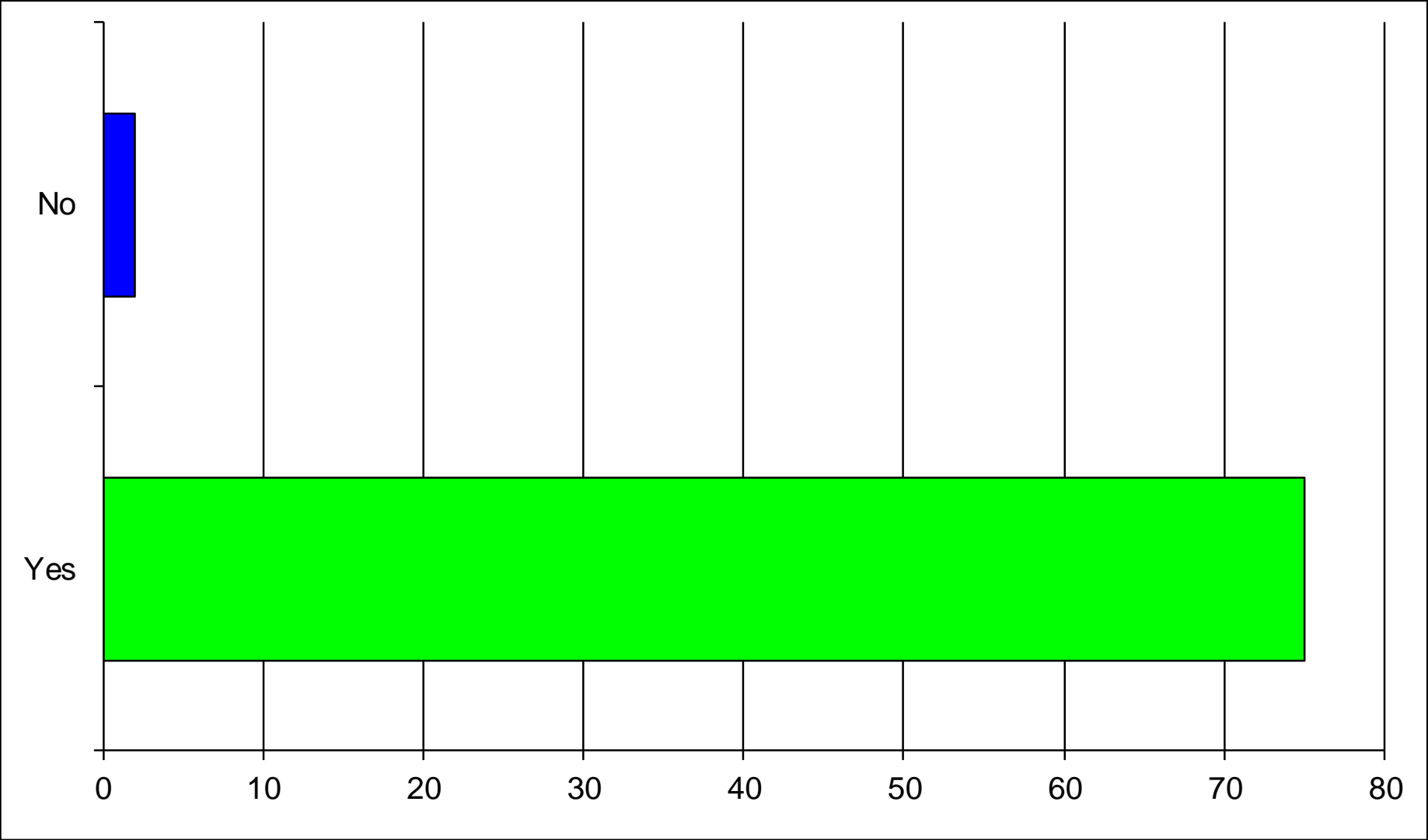
6. How do you plan to use Forum results?
