General:	The NHTSA Student Temporary Employment Program (STEP) provides learning and development opportunities and work experience for students in high school, vocational, technical, undergraduate (both associate and baccalaureate degree programs), and graduate programs.
Eligibility:	Students must be 16 years old. Students must be a US Citizen. Students must be enrolled in at least half-time courses as defined by the academic institution. Students must be in good academic standing to remain in the program.
Open to:	Students (enrolled in an accredited college or university, high school, technical or vocational school) enrolled or accepted in a diploma, certificate or a degree-seeking program. (e.g.; associate, undergraduate, or graduate).
Compensation	The salary ranges are based on educational background, prior work experience and volunteer experience.
Periods:	Spring, Summer, Fall, Winter
Selections Process:	NHTSA STEP Vacancy Announcement
Appointment Type:	Temporary "Paid" appointment which must be re-certified annually.
