

Mirror Lake Trailhead Relocation Project

► Fast Facts

Purpose: To relocate the parking and trailhead for the Mirror Lake Trail

Project Partners: Federal Hwy Administration (FHWA), Mt. Hood National Forest, Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT)

Project area: Hwy 26 (Mt Hood Highway) between the existing Mirror Lake Trailhead and the Ski Bowl parking lot.

Project Goals include:

- » Addressing unsafe parking conditions at the existing Mirror Lake Trailhead
- » Providing off-street parking for Mirror Lake visitors
- » Improving safe access for all travel modes
- » Minimizing impacts to natural and cultural resources

Project Cost: \$6,110,000

Funding Sources:

- » FHWA - \$5,520,000
- » USFS - \$150,000
- » ODOT - \$440,000

2016: Design Phase

2017-2018: Construction
