DOT-E 9009

- 1. Stauffer Chemical Company, Westport, Connecticut, is hereby granted an exemption from those provisions of this Department's Hazardous Regulations specified in paragraph 5 below to offer packages prescribed herein of a Poison B, liquid for transportation in commerce subject to the limitations and special requirements specified herein. This exemption authorizes the shipment of thiophosgene in DOT Specification 5C steel drums, and provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated.
- 2. <u>BASIS</u>. This exemption is based on Stauffer Chemical Company's application dated February 17, 1983, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.103 and the public proceeding thereon.
- 3. <u>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS</u> (Descriptor and class). Thiophosgene, classed as a Poison B.
- 4. PROPER SHIPPING NAME (49 CFR 172.101). Thiophosgene.
- 5. REGULATION AFFECTED. 49 CFR 173.356.
- 6. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Motor vehicle, rail freight, cargo vessel.
- 7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES. Packaging prescribed is a DOT Specification 5C steel drum constructed of 304 type stainless steel.
- 8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.
 - a. Persons who receive packages covered by this exemption may reship them pursuant to the provisions of 49 CFR 173.22a.
 - b. A copy of this exemption must be carried aboard each vessel, used to transport packages covered by this exemption.
- 9. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. Any incident involving loss of contents of the package must be reported to the Office of Hazardous Materials Regulation as soon as practicable.
