

1. Platte Chemical Company, Greeley, Colorado, is hereby granted an exemption from certain provisions of this Department's Hazardous Materials Regulations to offer packages prescribed herein of a Class B poisonous liquid for transportation in commerce subject to the limitations and special requirements specified herein. This exemption authorizes the shipment of a Parathion mixture, liquid, or a Methyl parathion mixture, liquid, in a DOT Specification 12P fiberboard box containing two inside DOT-2U polyethylene containers of 2-1/2 gallon capacity, and provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated. Each of the following is hereby granted the status as a party to the exemption:

The Gowan Company, Yuma, AZ - PTE-1.

2. BASIS. This exemption is based on Platte Chemical Company's application of May 12 and October 30, 1987, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.103 and 107.105 and the public proceeding thereon. The granting of party status is based on the following application submitted in accordance with 107.111 and the public proceeding thereon:

The Gowan Company's application dated November 13, 1987.

3. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (Descriptor and class). Ethyl parathion, liquid formulations, and Methyl parathion, liquid formulations, classed as Poison B liquid.

4. PROPER SHIPPING NAME (49 CFR 172.101). Parathion mixture, liquid, or Methyl parathion mixture, liquid, as appropriate.

5. REGULATION AFFECTED. 49 CFR 173.359.

6. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Motor vehicle.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES. Packaging prescribed is DOT specification 12P corrugated fiberboard box with two inside Specification 2U polyethylene containers of not over 2-1/2 gallon capacity each. Wire staples are not authorized for assembly or closure of boxes, except when polyethylene containers are completely enclosed in inside boxes free of wire staples or other projections that could cause failures. Packages shipped under this exemption must be capable of withstanding the procedures prescribed in 49 CFR 173.24(d).

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS. Persons who receive packages covered by this exemption may reshipe them pursuant to the provisions of 49 CFR 173.22a.

9. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. Any incident involving loss of contents of the package must be reported to the Office of Hazardous Materials Transportation as soon as practicable.

10. EXPIRATION DATE. June 30, 1989.
