DOT-E 9671

- 1. Ethyl Corporation, Baton Rouge, LA is hereby granted an exemption from those provisions of this Department's Hazardous Materials Regulations specified in paragraph 5 below to offer packages prescribed herein of a flammable compressed gas for transportation in commerce subject to the limitations and special requirements specified herein. This exemption authorizes the transportation of non-liquefied ethylene in DOT Specification 4BA240 cylinders, and provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated.
- 2. <u>BASIS</u>. This exemption is based on an application from Ethyl Corporation dated September 4, 1986, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.103 and the public proceeding thereon.
- 3. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (Descriptor and class). Non-liquefied ethylene classed as flammable gas.
- 4. PROPER SHIPPING NAME (49 CFR 172.101). Ethylene.
- 5. REGULATIONS AFFECTED. 49 CFR 173,302(a).
- 6. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Motor vehicle.
- 7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES. Packaging prescribed is a DOT Specification 4BA240 steel cylinder. The pressure in the cylinder must not exceed 125 psig at 70°F.
- 8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.
 - a. Persons who receive packages covered by this exemption may reship them pursuant to the provisions of 49 CFR 173.22a.
- 9. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS. Any incident involving loss of contents of the package must be reported to the Office of Hazardous Materials Transportation (OHMT) as soon as practicable.
- 10. EXPIRATION DATE. September 30, 1988.
