- 1. <u>GRANTEE:</u> United States Rail Services San Francisco, California.
- 2. <u>PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:</u> This exemption authorizes the transportation in commerce of certain Class 3 materials in DOT Specification 111A100W3 tank cars equipped with 1/2" thick full head shields and restencilled to DOT 111S100W3 and provides no relief from any regulations other than as specifically stated.
- 3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
- 4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 179.200-25
- 5. <u>BASIS</u>. This exemption is based on United States Rail Services' application of April 18, 1994, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.105.
- 6. <u>HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):</u>

7. PACKAGING(S) and SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. <u>PACKAGING</u> - Packaging prescribed is a DOT Specification 111A100W3 tank car meeting all DOT requirements (49 CFR Parts 100-199). The tank has been equipped with a 1/2" thick head shield constructed of ASTM A572-50 steel. The Certificates of Construction must be on file with the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety prior to offering the cars for transportation.

- b. MARKING Tank cars must be marked DOT-E 11143 in four inch letters and numerals on a contrasting background above the DOT specification number.
- c. <u>TESTING</u> The safety relief valves and tanks must be retested in accordance with the provisions for DOT 111A100W3 tank cars.
- 8. <u>SPECIAL PROVISIONS</u>. Persons who receive packages covered by this exemption may re-offer them for transportation provided no modifications or changes are made to the packages, all terms of this exemption are complied with, and a current copy of this exemption is maintained at each facility from which such re-offering occurs.
- 9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED. Rail freight.
- 10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: None as a condition of this exemption
- 11. <u>COMPLIANCE</u>. Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation laws:
 - O All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
 - O Registration required by 49 CFR 107.601 <u>et seg</u>., when applicable.

No person may use or apply of this exemption, including display of its number, when the exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect unless a regulation has been amended making the exemption no longer necessary.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

a. The Federal Railroad Administration is to be notified if any unusual incident, such as derailment or exterior tank car danger, occurs during the movement by contacting the:

The carrier is required to report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety (AAHMS) as soon as practicable. (49 CFR 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of the exemption.) In addition, the holder(s) of this exemption must inform the AAHMS, in writing, of any incidents involving the package and shipments made under the terms of this exemption.
