- 2. <u>PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:</u> This emergency exemption authorizes the transportation of uploaded combat vehicles containing certain Class 1 materials identified in paragraph 6 below. This exemption provides no relief from any regulations other than as specifically stated.
- 3. <u>REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED:</u> 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
- 4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 172.101 Column 8c; 172.504(a); 172.510(a); 173.60; 173.61; 173.62; 174.26(a); 174.81; Subpart E of Part 174, 176.76(a)(1).
- 5. <u>BASIS</u>. This emergency exemption is based on the DOD's applications of February 7 and March 11, 1994, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.113, and a determination that it is necessary for the protection of life and property.
