1. GRANTEE: Incendere, Inc.
Norfolk, VA
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This emergency exemption authorizes the one-way, one-time transportation in commerce of partially burned solid regulated medical waste in two non-DOT specification steel roll-off containers, loaded in an enclosed 53' medical waste trailer. This exemption provides no relief from any Hazardous Materials Regulation other than as specifically stated herein.
 - b. The safety analyses performed in development of this exemption only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce. The safety analyses did not consider the hazards and risks associated with consumer use, use as a component of a transport vehicle or other device, or other uses not associated with transportation in commerce.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR 171.8, 172.101 Table column 8(c) and 173.197 in that a non-DOT specification bulk packaging is authorized, and the marking requirement of §§ 172.302(b) and (c).
5. BASIS: This exemption is based on the application of Incendere, Inc. dated May 21, 1998, and supplemental information dated May 26, 1998, submitted in accordance with 49 CFR 107.117 and a determination that it is necessary to prevent significant injury to persons or property.

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR 172.101):

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. PACKAGING - Packagings prescribed are two (2) 40 cubic yard capacity metal open-topped roll-off containers. Each container is 24' long x 7'-8" wide x 8'-6" high. Each roll-off containers must be covered with a tarpaulin securely fastened and must be enclosed in a 53' trailer.

b. OPERATIONAL CONTROLS -

(1) The quantity of partially burned solid lading must not exceed 22 tons.

(2) The trailer must be fully closed and locked during transportation.

(3) No liquid lading is authorized.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:

a. This exemption is for the one-way, one-time transportation from Glens, Virginia to Phoenix Services, Inc., Baltimore Maryland.

b. Transportation must be by private motor carrier.

c. The marking requirements specified in §§ 172.302 (b) and (c) are waived.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A copy of this exemption must be carried aboard the motor vehicle used to transport packages covered by this exemption.
