2. **PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:** This exemption authorizes the holder of this exemption to perform the functions of a Registered Inspector without meeting certain requirements in 49 CFR § 171.8. This exemption provides no relief from any Hazardous Materials Regulation (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein.
3. **REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED:** 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. **REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED:** Under the definition of *Registered Inspector* in 49 CFR § 171.8(3), in that the holder does not have a high school diploma or General Equivalency Diploma; and § 171.8(4), in that the holder has at least 3 years experience in performing duties of a Registered Inspector by September 1, 1991, but did not register by December 1995.
5. **BASIS:** This exemption is based on the application of Daniel Dupuis dated February 12, 2003 submitted in accordance with § 107.109.
6. **SPECIAL PROVISIONS:** A current copy of this exemption must be maintained at each facility where the holder performs the function of a Registered Inspector.
7. **MODAL REQUIREMENTS:** None as a requirement of this exemption.

8. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:


- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this exemption must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this exemption in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when the exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

9. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: None as a requirement of this exemption.


