1. GRANTEE: Airgas, East
Binghamton, N.Y.
2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This emergency exemption authorizes the one-time transportation in commerce of Methylamine, anhydrous in a DOT Specification 4BA260 cylinder which developed a leak at the valve. The cylinder is equipped with a Chlorine Institute Emergency "A-Kit" to prevent leakage during transportation. This exemption provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein.
 - b. The safety analyses performed in development of this exemption only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce.
3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.
4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 172.301(c) in that marking the exemption number on the cylinder is not required; and § 173.34(d) in that a safety relief device is not required.
5. BASIS: This emergency exemption was issued based on the telephone conversation of June 17, 2002 with Airgas, East who provided information in accordance with § 107.117, resulting in a determination that issuing the exemption was necessary for the protection of life and the environment. A written application verifying the circumstances of the emergency was submitted on June 19, 2002.

6. HAZARDOUS MATERIALS (49 CFR § 172.101):

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. PACKAGING - Packaging prescribed is a DOT Specification 4BW260 cylinder which developed a leak at the valve. The cylinder is equipped with a Chlorine Institute emergency "A-Kit" to prevent leakage during transportation.

b. The cylinder must be braced and blocked to prevent movement during transportation.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: The cylinder will be transported by a motor vehicle owned and operated by Airgas Inc., and will be transported from Williamsport, Pa to the Airgas facility in Bladensburg, MD.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of this exemption must be carried aboard the motor vehicle used to transport the cylinder covered by this exemption.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:


- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, 49 CFR Parts 171-180.
- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this exemption must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this exemption in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when this exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: The carrier is required to report any incident involving loss of packaging contents or packaging failure to the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety (AAHMS) as soon as practicable. (Sections 171.15 and 171.16 apply to any activity undertaken under the authority of this exemption.) In addition, the holder(s) of this exemption must inform the AAHMS, in writing, of any incident involving the package and shipments made under the terms of this exemption.
