1. GRANTEE: Airgas - Nor Pac, Inc.
Portland, OR

2. PURPOSE AND LIMITATION:
 - a. This emergency exemption authorizes the one-time transportation in commerce of a DOT specification 4AA480 cylinder containing Anhydrous ammonia. The cylinder has a leak and is equipped with an Ammonia Emergency kit capping device. This exemption provides no relief from the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR) other than as specifically stated herein.

 - b. The safety analyses performed in development of this exemption only considered the hazards and risks associated with transportation in commerce.

3. REGULATORY SYSTEM AFFECTED: 49 CFR Parts 106, 107 and 171-180.

4. REGULATIONS FROM WHICH EXEMPTED: 49 CFR § 172.301(c) in that marking the exemption number on the cylinder is waived; and § 173.301(f) in that a safety relief device is not required.

5. BASIS: This emergency exemption is based on the application of Airgas, dated June 29, 2005, submitted in accordance with § 107.117 and a determination that it is necessary in order to protect life and property.

7. SAFETY CONTROL MEASURES:

a. PACKAGING - Packaging prescribed is a DOT specification 4AA480 cylinder which has a leak. The cylinder is equipped with an Ammonia Emergency kit. The emergency kit must prevent leakage during transportation.

b. OPERATIONAL CONTROLS -

(1) The cylinder will be transported from Portland, OR to Pasco, WA.

(2) The cylinder will be transported by an Oxarc, Inc. vehicle and must be accompanied by personnel trained in how to proceed in the event of an emergency.

8. SPECIAL PROVISIONS: A current copy of this exemption must be maintained at the facility where the package is offered for transportation.

9. MODES OF TRANSPORTATION AUTHORIZED: Motor vehicle.

10. MODAL REQUIREMENTS: A current copy of this exemption must be carried aboard the motor vehicle used to transport the package covered by this exemption.

11. COMPLIANCE: Failure by a person to comply with any of the following may result in suspension or revocation of this exemption and penalties prescribed by the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. 5101 et seq:

- o All terms and conditions prescribed in this exemption and the Hazardous Materials Regulations, Parts 171-180.
- o Persons operating under the terms of this exemption must comply with the security plan requirement in Subpart I of Part 172 of the HMR, when applicable.


- o Registration required by § 107.601 et seq., when applicable.

Each "Hazmat employee", as defined in § 171.8, who performs a function subject to this exemption must receive training on the requirements and conditions of this exemption in addition to the training required by §§ 172.700 through 172.704.

No person may use or apply this exemption, including display of its number, when this exemption has expired or is otherwise no longer in effect.

12. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS: Shipments or operations conducted under this exemption are subject to the Hazardous Materials Incident Reporting requirements specified in 49 CFR §§ 171.15 - Immediate notice of certain hazardous materials incidents, and 171.16 - Detailed hazardous materials incident reports. In addition, the grantee(s) of this exemption must notify the Associate Administrator for Hazardous Materials Safety -- OHMEA, in writing, of any incident involving a package, shipment or operation conducted under terms of this exemption.
