FINAL ORDER

By this Order, I find that Clean Harbors Recycling Services of Chicago, LLC (Respondent) committed three (3) violations of the Hazardous Materials Regulations (HMR), 49 C.F.R. Parts 171-180, and I assess Respondent a \$120,200 civil penalty.

On December 26, 2012, the Office of Chief Counsel issued an Amended Notice of Probable Violation (Notice) to Respondent proposing a \$120,200 civil penalty for three (3) violations of the HMR. On January 28, 2013, Respondent submitted a payment in the amount of \$120,200. By paying the full amount of the civil penalty proposed in the Notice, Respondent admitted the violations as alleged in the Notice (49 C.F.R. § 107.315). Therefore, I find that Respondent committed the violations as set forth in the Notice.

These violations shall constitute a prior violation under 49 U.S.C. § 5123 in the event Respondent commits any future violation of the Federal hazardous materials transportation law, 49 U.S.C. § 5101 et seq., or the HMR.

By paying the proposed civil penalty, Respondent waived all rights to further respond to the Notice and to appeal this Order. Accordingly, PHMSA accepts Respondent's January 28, 2013 payment in full satisfaction of the civil penalty proposed in the Notice and PHMSA shall close this case with prejudice.
