



# **How Does Interagency Coordination Work in Your State?**




# **Crash Data Collection and Reporting Process**




# **Crash Form**

- The lesson Design crash forms to facilitate collection of FMCSA data. Train law enforcement to use it properly, especially in working around design deficiencies.
- What FMCSA can do for you Review the crash form and offer recommendations. Tailor law enforcement training in crash data collection to your State's crash form.







# FMCSA Crash Definition

- The lesson Everyone in the State who identifies FMCSAreportable crashes needs to understand FMCSA's crash reporting criteria.
- What FMCSA can do for you Help you educate the people in your State agencies.




#### **Fatal Reporting**

- The lesson Know your Fatality Analysis Reporting System (FARS) Office. Schedule regular check-in times to make sure you are identifying all FMCSA-reportable fatal records.
- What FMCSA can do for you Provide reports and help explain FMCSA requirements to your FARS Office.



#### **Extract Logic & Code**


- The lesson Examine the extract code when presented with possible over- or under-reporting, or when Motor Carrier Management Information System data is not complete.
- What FMCSA can do for you Review extract to help determine whether it captures all reportable vehicles and data.



#### **Personnel Change**

- The lesson Talk to new employees in any agency if their work affects FMCSA data. Monitor the quality of data when new employees start working.
- What FMCSA can do for you Run reports that may help identify data quality issues resulting from a personnel change.





#### **Data Transfer**

- The lesson Coordinate regularly with other agencies to track the transfer of files. Pay particular attention when new systems or processes are adopted.
  - What FMCSA can do for you –
    Provide ways to track the transfer of files from one agency to the next, including custom reports.
