"...the Secretary of Transportation shall submit with the fiscal year 2005 budget request an action plan outlining specific efforts to be pursued by FRA, FHWA, FMCSA, NHTSA, and the ITS Joint Program Office to improve safety at both public and private grade crossings."

Action Plan

- Issued in June 1994
- FRA, FHWA, NHSTA & FTA
- 55 specific items
 - Crossing violations serious CDL offenses
 - Incentives for crossing closures
- Reduce collisions and fatalities by 50% in 10 years

6 Categories

- Law Enforcement
- Corridor reviews and improvements
- Educations and OL
- Private crossings
- Data and research
- Trespass

Results

	Fatalities	Incidents
1994	579	4633
2002*	355	3066
% change	- 39%	- 34%
