As a Federal service provider, the Department of Transportation (DOT) offers a range of business services to its Operating Administrations and other Federal organizations through its Enterprise Services Center (ESC). The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) requires Federal service providers to give client agencies annual independent auditors' reports describing associated internal controls in accordance with the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants' Statement on Standards for Attestation Engagements No.16 (SSAE-16). DOT and client agencies' auditors will use the results of this review in their fiscal year 2016 financial statement audits.

The Office of Inspector General (OIG) has contracted with KPMG, LLC, an independent public accounting firm, to conduct the review of ESC subject to OIG's oversight. The objectives of the review are to determine whether: (1) management's description of ESC's systems are fairly presented; (2) controls are suitably designed; and (3) controls are operating effectively throughout the period of October 1, 2015 through June 30, 2016. KPMG will do additional testing and issue a follow-up letter to our office for the period July 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016.

KPMG will begin its review this month, and is conducting it at the Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center (MMAC) in Oklahoma City. If you have any questions, please call me at (202) 366-1407.
