December 2001 CHANGES:

The Certificate of Destruction for LYNCH (dated 29 November 2001) was received from scrapping services contractor Transforma and processed.

STATUS NOTES:

- The Certificate of Destruction for EXPORT CHALLENGER is expected in January 2002.
- The scrapping of GEN ALEX M PATCH by contractor Esco Marine of Brownville, TX is approximately 15% complete.
- WAYNE VICTORY, under the custody of scrapping services contractor Transforma Marine, arrived in Brownsville, TX on December 12, 2001.
- The sales of BENJAMIN ISHERWOOD to CCC Marine and HENRY ECKFORD to Joseph D'Alessio & Company for use as NATO oilers are scheduled to close in mid-January 2002.
- The status of POTOMAC was changed from Deactivation to Militarily Useful Retention.
- The status of PROTECTOR was changed from Hold (Spare Equipment) Retention to Vessels Ready for Disposal.
- The status of GENERAL ALEX M PATCH and GENERAL NELSON WALKER were changed from Vessels Sold Awaiting Removal (which was erroneous) to Vessels Ready for Disposal.
- The four MARAD ships with Scrapping Services Contracts are: GENERAL ALEX M PATCH, WAYNE VICTORY, EXPORT CHALLENGER and LAUDERDALE.
- **Late Entry:** Titles for the former Reimbursable Navy Non-Retention ships MERRIMACK, MONONGEHELA, HOIST, VANGUARD, PLATTE, MOUNT HOOD and VANCOUVER were transferred to MARAD on 29 November 2001. Since early December 2001 these ships have been listed in NDRF Ready for Disposal Non-Retention status.
