September 2004 Changes

- Non-retention vessel PETREL (out of the JRRF) was destroyed (scrapping services contract) on September 9th.

CORRECTED VERSION (4 Nov 2004): Corrections made to Type Summary (summing error), Interim Hold and Stripping Status changes due to decision to delay downgrades to 1 October, and homeport (location) changes to SANTA CRUZ and AM RANGER now in Brownsville, TX vice the JRRF, effecting the location summary.

STATUS CHANGES and NOTES

- On September 1st, in accordance with the USTRANSCOM J5 memo of Jul 1st 2004, the following nine (9) RRF ships were downgraded to NDRF (Militarily Useful): Tankers MISSIONS CAPISTRANO and BUENAVENTURA; Troopships EMPIRE STATE and ENTERPRISE; Seabee CAPE MENDOCINO; CAPEs NOME, JOHN, JOHNSON and JUBY.
- 21 Non-retention vessels are currently under contract for disposal.
- An FY04 Annual Summary of Inventory Changes is provided at the beginning of this report.
- Beginning this month the Reserve Fleet Inventory report format has been changed. A glossary has been added to explain the new structure of vessel inventory classifications (programs and statuses).
