We have received your December 3, 1996, letter to Mr. Seppo I. Sillan which forwarded copies of a revised specifications sheet for the Guardian Barrier and the 350 Highway Kit, and your February 4 letter with final drawings of the barrier and connection detail. Copies of these final specifications and drawings are enclosed with this letter.

With receipt of these documents, which were requested in Mr. Seppo Sillan's November 14, 1996, letter to you, we find the Guardian Safety Barrier, with the 350 Highway Kit installed according to the enclosed drawings and specifications, acceptable as a TL-3 temporary barrier.
