Interactive Online Survivor Benefits Report

Background

To honor the promise, courage and sacrifice of those who have given the greatest sacrifice to their country, the Department of Defense commits to doing all it can to support the surviving families of service members. During this difficult time, the DoD has provided survivor benefits reports to surviving spouses and eligible dependent children. To improve the level of support to surviving family members, the DoD has introduced a new, online, interactive benefits report for surviving spouses that provides the benefits information.

Highlights

The new interactive online survivor benefits report:

- Is available for surviving spouses of all service members who have died on active duty
- Can be accessed 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
- Displays current and estimated future benefits and allows survivors to input “what if” type changes to family members’ education status and plans, disability status and marital status. Current or “what if” reports can be saved or printed.
- Provides a Family Assistance Support Team to assist in accessing the Interactive Online Survivor Benefits Report site and to help understand benefits
- Requires surviving spouses to have a DoD self-service logon premium account — or DS logon premium account — and password. (The DS logon is a secure, self-service logon ID that allows individuals affiliated with the DoD or Department of Veterans Affairs to access several websites using a single username and password.)
