Workspace Version – 1.0

These instructions are based on a default installation of MicroStation and GEOPAK.

The workspaces are contained in a ZIP file, WFLHD_WS_V8i_SS3.zip. If possible, extract to the root of C:\ drive. When WFLHD_WS_V8i_SS3.zip is extracted you'll find the following new folder(s)

WFL Workspaces

GEOPAK

MAP

MicroStation

Project_Configurations

V1 Ext Resources.txt

1. Open folder "C:\WFL Workspaces\Project_Configurations" copy WFL_AE_English.pcf and WFL_AE_Metric.pcf to C:\ProgramData\Bentley\MicroStation V8i (SELECTseries)\WorkSpace\Projects

If you extracted the WFLHD_WS_V8i_SS3.zip file to C:\ then you're done. If however you extracted the WFLHD_WS_V8i_SS3.zip to a different location, you'll need to modify the two new PCF files.

2. Open C:\ProgramData\Bentley\MicroStation V8i (SELECTseries)\WorkSpace\Projects\WFL_AE_English.pcf with a text editor such as Notepad or Notepad++
3. Go to line 23
4. Line 23 reads "Resource_Path = C:/WFL Workspaces"
5. Change C:/WFL_Workspaces to the location you extracted the WFLHD_WS_V8i_SS3.zip file to.
 - a. If you extracted the file to "M:\Workspaces\" then line 23 would read "Resource_Path = M:/Workspaces/ WFL_Workspaces"
 - b. Note the "/" rather than "\" in the path.
6. Do steps 2 – 5 to WFL_AE_Metric.pcf

When you open MicroStation select the corresponding PDF for the project from the "Project" dropdown list box.
