WORK ZONE SAFETY

The National Highway Institute (NHI) is pleased to announce the launching of our Certificate of Accomplishment Program. Beginning October 1, 2006, NHI is offering Certificates of Accomplishment to recognize individuals who have successfully completed and achieved passing grades in selected groupings of related NHI course offerings. The Certificate Program features suites of complementary NHI courses bundled together to enable participants to enhance their depth and breadth of knowledge and expertise in specific disciplines or topic areas.

COURSE SUITE: The Certificate of Accomplishment in Work Zone Safety features the following four NHI courses:

- FHWA-NHI-380003—Design and Operation of Work Zone Traffic Control
- FHWA-NHI-380060—Work Zone Traffic Control for Maintenance Operations
- FHWA-NHI-380063—Construction Zone Safety Inspection
- FHWA-NHI-380072—Advanced Work Zone Management and Design (Available Spring 2007)

BENEFITS: The Certificate of Accomplishment in Work Zone Safety offers participants the following benefits:

- Courses are taught by expert instructors who have real-world experience in the fields of work zone safety and traffic control
- Interactive sessions feature best practices regarding the safest and most efficient strategies and technologies for managing traffic in work zones
- Participants will have the opportunity to network with other professionals and benefit from a wide range of perspectives and experiences
- Participants will receive the latest regulatory information and guidance as they proceed through the courses

TARGET AUDIENCE: Personnel from FHWA, State Departments of Transportation (DOTs), county and local governments, and the private sector who are responsible for designing, installing, monitoring, and inspecting work zone traffic control devices and strategies.

REQUIREMENTS: Any course sessions successfully completed and passed within the Work Zone Safety course suite since January 1, 2004, are eligible for inclusion in the Certificate of Accomplishment Program. Sessions attended prior to that date are not eligible. No waivers or substitutions will be accepted. All the courses in the suite must be completed within four years of taking the first course. To be eligible to receive a Certificate of Accomplishment, participants must complete and pass the exam for each course in the suite. After successfully completing all the courses in the suite, please contact the NHI Training Coordinator at nhitraining@dot.gov to request your Certificate of Accomplishment.

ENROLLMENT: Customers can login, enroll, and pay their individual fees via the NHI Web site at www.nhi.fhwa.dot.gov. FHWA participants should ask their local training coordinator to register them through the U.S. DOT Electronic Learning Management System (eLMS).
